



Oncology Center, Behavioral Health Hospital, medical offices part of \$40M expansion plans

Edinburg, Texas.- South Texas leaders on Thursday, December 14, gathered in Edinburg to celebrate the city's continuing transformation into a medical center leader for the Rio Grande Valley, breaking ground for a \$40 million expansion of Doctors Hospital at Renaissance.

More than 100 physicians, medical staff members, political and community leaders, including the entire Hidalgo County state representative delegation, attended the 10 a.m. event, held at the site that will be home to a cancer treatment facility, behavioral health complex, and a multi-level medical office structure.
